THE PARENTS OF ALL NEW BOYS.


I am very happy to welcome your son to Heath Grammar School next term, and congratulate him on his success. As I am sure you will have a great many questions to ask, I am holding a meeting of the parents of all new boys in the School Hall on Friday, 1st. September, at 7.15 p.m., to which you are most cordially invited. I shall speak at some length on the purpose and general conduct of the School and then invite questions. As most of what I say will concern the problems of parents and Masters in relation to the boys, I most particularly ask you not to bring your boy to this meeting.

I enclose a few notes which you may find useful. I am sorry that the intervention of the School holidays forces me to issue this invitation so far in advance, but I nevertheless hope that you will book the date and make every effort to attend. Close personal contact between Masters and parents is absolutely essential at all stages of a boy's education at a Grammar School, but never more so than during the first year.

In the meantime, you will wish to have early information about the school uniform your boy will require next term. You will notice that certain items are in special House colours, and you are particularly asked to make sure that you obtain only the correct ones as indicated at the foot of this letter.

As I shall be extremely busy with routine work until the end of this term, I shall be most grateful if parents will refrain from asking to see me until after the beginning of next term, when I shall be happy to see them at any time, by appointment.
